## **SC State Vs. Air Force**

### Historic Season

South Carolina State will celebrate its 100th year of football during the 2007 season. The Bulldogs played their first collegiate football contest in 1907 against Morehouse. Since that inaugural contest, SC State has gone on to establish a rich legacy in football, producing a host of professional players and three NFL Hall of Famers -- Marion Motley (Cleveland Browns), Deacon Jones (Los Angeles Rams/San Diego Chargers) and Harry Carson (NY Giants). In addition to celebrating its Centennial in football, the University will also be playing two Football Bowl Subdivision (formerly Div. I-A) teams for the first time -- Air Force, this week's opponent and the University of South Carolina on Sept. 15. Sandwiched in between those two games is a pivotal conference matchup at Bethune-Cookman in Daytona Beach. The three-game stretch is one of the most ambitious ever for Coach Buddy Pough's team.

**BULLDOGS TO WATCH**

**Marshall McFadden**  
**Bandit**  
**Lamar, SC**



McFadden, a preseason MEAC first-team selection, has started all 22 games during his two-year career, returns for his junior campaign and is expected to be the defensive leader for the Bulldogs. A very versatile player, he rotated between linebacker and safety last season, recording 43 tackles, fourth-best on the team. He has settled in as the "Dog" safety this year, his third as a starter.

**Cleveland McCoy**  
**Quarterback**  
**Hollywood, SC**



Senior quarterback Cleveland McCoy will be the starting signal caller for a third consecutive season. McCoy, a first-team All-MEAC selection in 2005 and a second-team choice in 2006, has passed for almost 3,000 yards (2,979) and 25 touchdowns during his career, completing 208 of 387 attempts for a 53.7 completion percentage. He is expected to end his career as one of the school's top passers. He has also been effective as a runner, averaging over 40 yards per game with 12 career rushing touchdowns.

**Stephen Grantham**  
**Placekicker**  
**Florence, SC**



Stephen Grantham, who was very effective as a freshman two years ago when he was forced into the starting duties after a preseason injury to senior Michael Gaston, returns to the squad after missing all of last season. He is expected to be a real weapon for the Bulldogs with his accuracy and distance on field goals. He was 9-15 on FGs and 45-51 on PATs as a true freshman.

## DID YOU KNOW

### Wins

Dating back to last season, the Bulldogs are currently on a three-game winning streak and have won six of their last seven contests.

### Bulldogs in Season Openers

The Bulldogs are 44-30-2 in season openers since 1925. Under head coach Oliver 'Buddy' Pough, the Bulldogs have a 3-2 record in season openers.

### Pough in TV Games

SCSU head coach Oliver 'Buddy' Pough is currently 1-0 in nationally televised games and will get a chance to improve on that record this year as SC State has one national telecast this season -- Oct. 13 at home against Florida A&M on ESPNU. In regional telecasts, Pough is 2-3. This week's game is being televised regionally over mtn(the Mountain West Conference Sports Network).

### Pough in Neutral Site Games

Quietly, Pough has also dominated neutral site games as a 11-2 record in neutral site games including a perfect records (4-0) in the Rivalry Classic against North Carolina A&T and Benedict (3-0) in the Palmetto Capitol City Classic.

His only neutral site losses have come at the hands of the Tennessee State Tigers (20-37) at Adelphia Stadium in Nashville, Tennessee in 2003 and against Bethune-Cookman in the Lowcountry Classic at Charleston in 2006.

### The Lamar Factor

Tiny Lamar High School, Lamar, SC has been a recruiting boom for SC State, which this year, has five players from the three-time state championship school on its roster. Four of the five play in the secondary and three are starters. The three starters are junior Marshall McFadden, who plays the "Bandit" position on the Bulldog squad this season and has started all 22 games during his career; redshirt sophomore LaQuinn Ellerbe, the starting free safety and whose brother Dewitt was a starter for the Bulldogs four years ago; and Markee Hamlin, also a redshirt sophomore, who starts at strong safety. Other Lamar products on the 2007 team include Desmond Benjamin, a converted running back who is a reserve defensive back and Latron Jackson, a reserve wide receiver. The only other high school with more than two players on the 2007 squad is Miami (Fla.) Killian with three.

### BIG SHOES TO FILL

For the first time in four years, SC State will not have versatile and powerful running back DeShawn Baker in the back field. Baker departed #2 on the Bulldog all-time rushing list and was MEAC Offensive Player of the Year in a senior. His big shoes this year will be filled by two smaller, but talented backs in Will Ford (5-10, 180), the MEAC Rookie of the Year last season and Jonathan Woods (6-0, 205). Ford was second in rushing last year with 742 yards and ten TDs.

## SC STATE OUTLOOK

### "100 Years of Bulldog Football

South Carolina State will celebrate 100 Years of Bulldog Football during the 2007 season, and the Bulldogs will do it amid the school's most ambitious schedule ever. SC State, which has never faced a major university on the gridiron, will take on two Football Bowl Subdivision (formerly Div. I-AA) opponents this season. Coach Buddy Pough's team opens the campaign at the Air Force Academy on Sept. 1, and two weeks later, travels forty miles up I-26 to Columbia to face intrastate rival South Carolina in football for the first time. In between the two FBS teams, the Bulldogs must travel to Daytona Beach to face Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference rival and perennial power Bethune-Cookman, the team that handed the Bulldogs their most lopsided loss last year (21-45). SC State, however, is expected to put one of its most talented teams on the field this season. Forty-six letter winners, including twenty-six on offense, return from last season's team, which rebounded from a 1-3 start to finish 7-4 overall and 6-2 in the MEAC, good enough for a second-place tie. The SC State offense will be directed by senior quarterback Cleveland McCoy (6-2, 215) who will be starting for a third straight season. The offensive line, led by center Raymond Harrison, an MEAC first-team selection last year, and tackles James Lee and Nate Richardson, is a seasoned one, the wide receiver corps is deep and the backfield one of strength with Will Ford, last year's MEAC Rookie of the Year, and Jonathan Woods, a 2005 standout, carrying most of the load. On defense, where seventeen lettermen are back the defensive front is not quite as experienced as in 2006 but more athletic, and the line-backing corps and secondary return almost intact. The unit is expected to emerge as one of the most productive in the MEAC. In the area of special teams, SC State lost a reliable kicker in Michael Gaston, however, Steve Grantham, an all-conference caliber kicker, who was a sensation as a freshman but missed all of last year, is back and should be counted on to do a good job. The punting duties will fall to sophomore Aaron Haire, who is very gifted and had a solid spring.

## The Coaching Matchup



**Oliver "Buddy" Pough** is in his sixth season as head coach at South Carolina State, his alma mater. In five seasons at the helm of the Bulldog program, Pough has compiled a 40-17 overall worksheet and a 29-10 MEAC mark with just three conference losses the last two seasons. SC State was 7-4 last season and finished tied for second in the MEAC at 6-2. Pough became the 14th head football coach at SC State in 2002, taking over the reins from Willie Jeffries, who retired after a 19-year career at the University. He posted a 7-5 overall record and a 4-4 worksheet in his first season. The next year, the Bulldogs improved to 8-4 and 6-2 in the league. He followed those marks with back to back 9-2 seasons in 2004 and 2005, sharing the regular season title with nationally-ranked Hampton in 2004. Last season the Bulldogs dipped to 7-4 overall and 6-2 in the league. Prior to returning to his alma mater as head coach, Pough spent five seasons at the University of South Carolina, the last three as running backs coach under Lou Holtz. During his stint at USC, he helped build the Gamecocks into one of the top offensive teams in the Southeastern Conference (SEC). USC made back-to-back appearances in the Outback Bowl in 2000 and 2001. Before going to USC, Pough was one of the top high school coaches in the Palmetto State, leading Fairfield-Central to a perfect 15-0 record in 1996 and claiming the Class AAA state title. He earned SCHSL Coach of the Year honors for his efforts, the first of three such honors. Pough also had coaching stints at Keenan High in Columbia, where he built the Raiders into one of the top Class AAA teams in the state. An Orangeburg native and former offensive lineman for SC State, Pough helped the Bulldogs amass a 16-6-1 record during the 1974 and 1974 seasons, a span in which SC State suffered just two MEAC losses and captured a pair of league titles. After graduating in 1975, he joined the staff at nearby Orangeburg-Wilkinson High (1976-79), before returning to his alma mater as an assistant coach in 1979. The Bulldogs made consecutive trips to the Div. I-AA playoffs (1981 & 1982) during his tenure as an assistant. Pough and his wife, Josie, are the parents of two sons--Oliver "Bud" and Lee Judson.

### Troy Calhoun



Calhoun, a 1989 Academy graduate, is the sixth head coach in school history and first graduate to hold the position. He brings with him an impressive resume at the collegiate and professional levels that is flooded with success at every stop.

Calhoun is fresh off completing his first season with the Houston Texans as offensive coordinator/quarterbacks coach. The 2006 Texans were one of only two

NFL teams to triple their number of wins from the previous year.

Calhoun became a well-rounded NFL coach, working as a defensive assistant, special teams assistant and offensive assistant with the Denver Broncos from 2003-05. He began his NFL coaching career by serving as the defensive assistant under defensive coordinator Larry Coyer in 2003. He was a part of the NFL's fourth-ranked defense. The Broncos' defense ranked seventh against the run and sixth against the pass. Denver's defense yielded a mere 17.6 points per game as they made the playoffs for the first time since 2000.

In 2004, Denver utilized Calhoun's offensive prowess moving him to offensive assistant/special teams. On the offensive side of the ball, the Broncos ranked fifth in the NFL, averaging 395.8 yards per game. Broncos' quarterback Jake Plummer set a team record for passing with 4,089 yards and tied a team record with 27 touchdown passes. Coupled with an outstanding passing attack, the Broncos finished fourth in the NFL in rushing. The offense's ability to combine the run and the pass led to Denver ranking second in the NFL in time of possession with 32:37 per game. The Broncos' special teams connected on 29 field goals, second best in the NFL.

### SCOUTING THE TEAMS

**On the Bulldogs:** The Bulldogs, picked to win the MEAC this year, will face perhaps their most formidable challenge in football Saturday when they take on Air Force. It is not quite "David vs. Goliath" but it may come close. Despite being "the best-conditioned team we've had since I have been here" according to Coach Pough, SC State will have to deal with an opponent with greater resources, bigger and perhaps stronger players, and an altitude that has slowed down many. In addition, The Falcon coaching staff is new and not much is known about what Coach Troy Calhoun and his staff will do. So Pough and his staff have been busy preparing his team for many scenarios. But, what matters most, is what the Bulldogs do. Pough noted in his weekly press conference that his team need to operate at a high level of efficiency and not make mistakes. Senior quarterback Cleveland McCoy will be the catalyst for SC State. He must play well. He is starting for a third straight season and is anxious to finish his career on a high note. "How Cleve goes, is how our team will go," Pough said earlier. "We must go out and compete and I think that is the measure we will use to determine if the game was a success or not."



**On the Falcons:** Air Force will be playing its 12th Football Championship Subdivision (formerly Div. I-AA) team, and in their previous 11 meetings with such teams, the Falcons have emerged as winners. Included among their conquests are two Palmetto State teams - The Citadel in 1990, 1993 and 1997, and Wofford in 2003. The last FCS team Air Force played was Eastern Washington in 1994. Only two of the games against smaller schools have been close, both against The Citadel -- 10-7 in 1990 and 17-3 in 1997. So it appears that the Bulldogs will be in for a tough outing as the Falcons are a formidable foe at home in season openers. Air Force has won its last two home openers, including 10 in a row to unranked opponents. Senior quarterback Shaun Carney, a four-year starter, will direct the Falcon offense. He ranks third in career total offense at Air Force with 5,824 total yards and was selected to the Davey O'Brien National Quarterback Award "watch list" for a third straight year. "The Carney kid for them is a very special player," Pough noted. "He has been not only a good passer, but he's real athletic and seems to be a good fit for the things they would possibly do. He's someone you have to pay some special attention to (on defense)."
